


May 1st will be the reveal and book signing of the Chidren's book! Look for more details on this event from Diane Parker and her fabulous and committed team!



### MANDARIN ORANGE UPSIDE DOWN CAKE

10 Mandarin Oranges, peeled and slided in half, across

1/2 c Unsalted Butter (1 Stick)

1 c Light brown sugar

1 Box Yellow Cake Mix

Preheat oven to 350.

Prepare the cake mix according to directions - set aside.

In 9" x 13" pan - melt the butter and add the Light Brown sugar and mix until combined. Arrange the sliced Mandarin oranges in the sugar and butter mixture.

Pour the ccake mixture over the Mandarin orange and brown sugar mixture. Bake according to the cake mix.

Remove from the oven and let cool slightly. Place serving platter over the baking pan and invert the cake, let the brown sugar and butter mixture release onto the cake.

Remove the baking dish and let the cake cool completely. Cut and serve. Can be served with whipping cream or vanilla ice cream.

## PINEAPPLE PISTACHIO PUDDING BARS

2-1/2 Pkgs Shortbread cookies (Walkers 4.7 oz Shortbread Cookies)

Crushed into Fine Crumbs, using a food processor

1/2 Cup Unsalted butter, melted

8 oz Pkg Cream cheese, softened
 14 oz Can Sweetened Condensed milk

1/4 Cup Freshly squeezed lime juice

1 Small Pkg. Instant Pistachio Pudding

8 oz Can Crushed Pineapple, with the juice

1/2 Cup Heavy Whipping cream

### Preheat oven to 350.

Combine cookie crumbs with the butter until combined. Press firmly I nto ungreased 9" x 13" baking pan. Bake 8 to 10 minutes. Let cool completely. Whip the heavy whipping cream until peaks stand when whisk is removed. Beat cream cheese in large bowl until fluffy, about 5 minutes. Add the sweetened condensed milk and beat until combined. Add lime juice and continue beating until combined. Add the pudding mix and beat until smooth. Stir in the pineapple until combined. Gently fold in the whipping cream until no more white streaks can be seen.

Pour into prepared pan with the cooled crust and refrigerate overnight. For decoration, crushed pistachio nuts can be sprinkled over the top.
